#### REPORTS:

- A. **Secretaries Report** - Brenda provided a review of the October 19 meeting.
- B. **Treasures Report** - Sue provided a financial overview: Checking - \$202.60 Savings - \$12,344.75
- C. **Price County Snowmobile Assoc.** - Mike LeDuc distributed the new trail maps.
- D. **Trail Preparation** - Lawrence and Ron reported on completed trail work.

#### OLD BUSINESS:

- A. **Equipment** - The club four wheeler was sold for \$1,800. Money will be deposited in the savings account. Special thanks to Lawrence for taking charge of the sale. Thanks to Rich Wojcieszak for his time and mileage to distribute the for sale information.
- B. **Web Site** - The status of the club web site was discussed. Bill Nemec, **Minding Your Business**, is in the process of finalizing the site. The club discussed a variety of site links, i.e. Snow tracks, John Dees.com, that will enhance area awareness and will further advertise the trails and local business and encourage greater tourist interest. The club expects to sell advertisement for local business on the trail to pay for the web site development. Advertisement fees are not final, and will be discussed at the next meeting.
- C. **Membership** - Follow up renewal letters were sent to all non renewed members. Membership posters were completed and will be distributed to area business on and off the trails to introduce the club and invite interested persons to join.

#### NEW BUSINESS:

- A. **2010-2011 Planning/goal setting**
  - a. **Apparel-Logo** - Laurie Sylvia presented prices for clothing/hats etc. to be reviewed. A new club logo was approved with the colors as presented. Laurie will follow up to place an order for items to be ready for the kick off party December 4. Business owners will purchase a variety of apparel items to be sold.
  - b. **Trail promotion** - The new "**YOU ARE HERE**" signs are completed. Posts for signs have been erected and signs are ready to be mounted. The club heard reports from Dan Sylvia and Eric Scharp regarding the value of a club web site and the future use of a **Web Cam** to further promote the trails and area business.
  - c. **Social activities** - In addition to the club calendar of events, the monthly newsletter will continue to list area events and activities sponsored by local businesses and Price County snowmobile clubs. Club rides will be organized to support area events and fundraisers.
  - d. **Fund raising** - The club considered a variety of options for fundraising this year. The conclusion was to not organize a raffle as the economy is difficult. The membership decided on: **50-50 Raffles at all meetings and events, proceeds from trail map donations, Super bowl pool, sale of apparel, Chili Cook-off, and the Pancake breakfast.**

- A. **Ski Doo** - Mike and Brenda reviewed the annual Ski Doo fundraising opportunity for local snowmobile clubs. By completing individual club membership forms, a financial reimbursement is given to the club for every completed form. ## TRAIL MAP- INTERSECTION SIGNS (Could save your life)

The **NEW** Price County Trail maps are available. As you continue to use them, please keep in mind that they offer a variety of information to help with a safe and fun riding experience. Along with information regarding: Corridor, County, Federal, and State trails, the **INTERSECTION** signs are provided to assist in rider location and safety on trails.

These **TWO DIGIT SIGNS** are located throughout the Price County trail system at key intersections. In the event of an emergency, the 911 operator will ask you for this number. The emergency response system can identify these numbers and give important location information to rescue personnel. This will greatly improve response time for emergency responders and could be a matter of life or death.
