PRICE COUNTY TRAIL MAP- INTERSECTION SIGNS (Could save your life)

Please keep in mind that the maps provide a variety of information to help with a safe and fun riding experience. Along with information regarding: <u>Corridor</u>, <u>County</u>, <u>Federal</u>, and <u>State</u> trails, the <u>INTERSECTION</u> signs are provided to assist in rider location and safety on trails.

These <u>TWO DIGIT SIGNS</u> are located throughout the Price County trail system at key intersections. In the event of an emergency, the 911operator will ask you for this number. The emergency response system can identify these numbers and give important location information to rescue personnel. This will greatly improve response time for emergency responders and could be a matter of life or death.
